

Savings Scheme

What is it?

Is there a minimum amount?

Is it an insurance scheme?

No. This scheme is purely to help save towards the cost of vet bills.

Can I obtain credit on my savings account?

No. This does not operate as a credit system. The amount saved may be used to pay a bill but if there should be a shortfall we will ask you to pay the balance at the time of your visit.

Is interest payable on my account?

No.

Do I have to give notice to cancel my account?

No notice is required. You may cancel this agreement at any time and the funds will be returned to you.
